

Creating a Smart Music Student Account

Due: February 5, 2017

By completing this assignment you will be enrolled as a SmartMusic user. You do NOT have to purchase a subscription to SmartMusic, this will simply allow you access to the SmartMusic practice room subscription on the instrumental music iPads. (You are more than welcome to purchase a subscription that would allow you to practice with smart music and take tests from your computer or iPad at home, but this is NOT required).

1. Go to: <https://gradebook.smartmusic.com>
 - You should see “Create a New Account” on the left and “Existing Customer” on the right.
 - If you have created a SmartMusic account in the past and remember your username and password, type them into the “Existing Customer” section.
 - You may be taken to a page to update your profile. Make any updates, click on save, and click on HOME in the top left corner (next to My Account).
 - If you do not have a SmartMusic account, create a new account.
 - Enter your grade, ensemble, years you’ve played, and instrument and click “save”.
2. On the next screen click, scroll down to “enroll” and click to enroll in a class.
3. Click Concert Band, Symphony Band, Wind Ensemble, or Orchestra (the class in which you are enrolled).
 - If you are in more than one class, you can register in each class.

You are now enrolled and can start using smart music on the music iPads to take scale quizzes and practice your parts for pieces we are preparing for performance!

To complete the assignment, log into Google Classroom, click on the Google Forms link, and complete the form. You will need to provide your login and password for Smart Music so Mrs. Wickman has record of your account and can access your login if you forget it.
